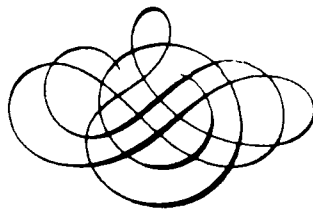

Numbering System

Many different numbering systems are used in family histories. The numbering system used in this family history, and sequence of descendants, is simple and easy to follow and understand. With the following explanation, all descendants should be able to identify and follow their direct line. The following is an example:

- 1 Jacob Peters, the first proven ancestor.
1. 2 Samuel Peters, the second child of No. 1.
1. 2. 8 John Peters, the eighth child of No. 1. 2.
1. 2. 8. 4 Esther Elizabeth Emaline Peters, the fourth child of No. 1. 2. 8.
1. 2. 8. 4. 1 Roscoe Ervin Doty, the first child of No. 1. 2. 8. 4.
1. 2. 8. 4. 1. 2 Mary Emma Doty, the second child of No. 1. 2. 8. 4. 1.
1. 2. 8. 4. 1. 2. 1 Mary Alice Gleason, the first child of No. 1. 2. 8. 4. 1. 2.

If at some future date No. 1. 2. 8. 4. 1. 2. 1, Mary Alice Gleason should marry and have children, her first child would be assigned No. 1. 2. 8. 4. 1. 2. 1. 1.

In this system no two people have the same number. At one glance at her number, Mary Alice would immediately know that the last number one is her own reference; working backwards, the next number two is her mother; the next number one is her grandfather; the next number four is her great-grandmother; the next number eight is her great-great grandfather; the next number two is her third great grandfather; and the next, number one, Jacob Peters, is her fourth great-grandfather.

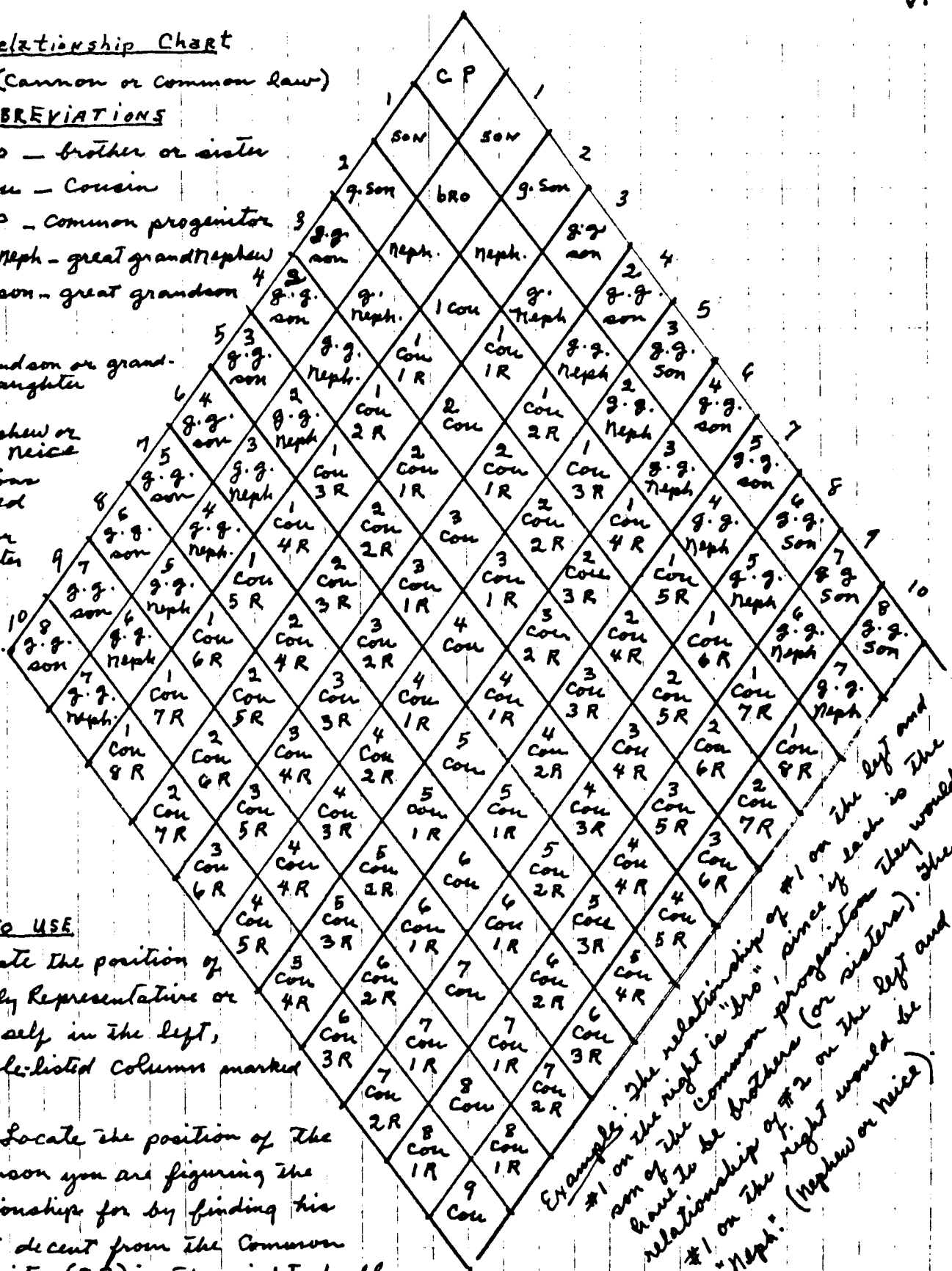

How To USE

1. Locate the position of Family Representative or yourself in the left, double-listed columns marked 1-10
2. Locate the position of the person you are figuring the relationship for by finding his direct decent from the Common progenitor (CP) in the right, double-lined column 1-10.
3. The correct relationship will be found where these two lines cross.

EXAMPLE: The relationship of #1 on the left and son of the right is "bro" since if each is the relationship of the Common progenitor they would be brothers (or sisters). The relationship of #1 on the left and #2 on the right would be "Neph." (Nephew or niece).

THE PETERS FAMILY

There are several versions of who the parents of Jacob Peters are and when they came to America but we are agreed that they had several children, among whom are the following:

1. John Peters, born 1770 and died at the age of 75 years. His wife, Catherine, was born 1781 and died 1 Jan. 1859. They had a daughter, Anna, b. 1795, and died 25 July 1855 of fever. They had other children.

* 2. Henry Peters, b. 1771 (or most probably 1763, since he died 16 Aug. 1859 at the age of 96 years. See below.

3. Samuel Peters, born probably about 1772. He was, probably, the same Samuel Peters who paid taxes in Carter County, Tennessee in 1794 and in 1796.

4. Jesse Peters, may have been a brother though nothing is known about him.

5. Jacob Peters, born 1778. See The Peters Family, following.

6. Annie Peters, nothing more is known about her.



* 2. Henry Peters, was born 1763, and died 16 Aug. 1859 at the age of 96 years. He owned land in Russell Co., Va. adjoining his brother Jacob as early as 1803. His wife's name was

Mary (Polly). They had at least two sons and probably more.

THE PETERS FAMILY



Our Peters family came from the Baden area of Southern Germany known as the "Black Forests" and they referred to themselves as "Black Dutch" (Dutch).

Our earliest proven ancestor is Jacob Peters who was born in Rockbridge County, Virginia in 1778. Bible records in the possession of J. R. Peters in Burgettstown, Pennsylvania, show Jacob to have three brothers — Henry, John, and Samuel. There were probably other children.

For our family history, I will begin with
1. Jacob Peters, born 1778 in Rockbridge Co., Virginia. He died 23 August 1862. He married Catherine Hacker, born 1781 to Jonas and Elizabeth Hacker. She died 1 January 1859. They had fourteen children — all born in Scott Co., Virginia. The earliest land deed I have found of Jacob is for 100 acres in 1803 from Timothy Pennington. Witnessing the signing of that deed were Jacob Peeters, Martin Peeters, David and John Gillam. He registered 200 acres in 1806 and bought 100 acres more in 1811 which was bounded by land already bought from Joseph Hacker. I haven't found that deed. He witnessed to land sold which bounded his own and that of Henry Peters. He bought 300 acres in 1821; 300 ac. in 1828; and, 100 acres in 1830. It is said Jacob gave each of his fourteen children 100 acres before his death. They are:

1.1 Elizabeth Peters, oldest daughter of Jacob and Catherine Peters, was born 1799 (according to the 1860 Census, she was 61 years old; a widow living with her father, Jacob.) However, one researcher gives her birth year as 1800. If that be so then she would be a twin to Samuel, since in his bible, his birth is recorded as 13 Sept. 1800. Elizabeth married first 23 Sept. 1816 to Joseph Duncan. They had two daughters:

- 1.1.1 _____ Duncan. She married John Mann.
- 1.1.2 Susan Duncan. She married Joseph Mann a brother to John Mann and to Robert Mann who married Alice Peters.

After the death of Joseph Duncan, Elizabeth married Noah Bolton on Feb. 1843.



1. 2 Samuel Peters, the oldest son of Jacob and Catherine Peters, was born September 13, 1800. He died September 10, 1868. On April 1, 1824, he married Esther Weaver who was born April 31, 1805. She died in Greene Co., Tennessee September 18, 1882. Samuel moved to Tennessee and bought land. The first tract being 96 acres lying on Sinking Creek and joining that of Frederick Weaver, (who may have been Esther's father) — for a sum of Three hundred and Twenty dollars. He and his brother, John Braddock Peters, are said to have made the first threshing machine used in this area of the country. Samuel's Bible is in the possession of this writer — Mary Sloty Gleason — a great-great-granddaughter of Samuel and Esther. The Bible has recorded in it the births, deaths, and marriages of Samuel and Esther, and of some of their children. They had thirteen children:

1.2.5 Jacob Peters, fifth child of Samuel and Esther Peters, was born Feb. 9, 1832, and died April 3, 1901. He married first to Ruth Emeline Bales, b. Jan. 4, 1839; d. May 28, 1876. He married second on April 11, 1878 to Nancy Corenda Greer who was born Sept. 1, 1841 and died July 9, 1909.

Jacob and Ruth E. belonged to the Quaker Church. Ruth Emeline was granted a certificate to the Newberry monthly meeting the 23rd Nov. 1861. Jacob and sons Samuel E. and Joseph A. were received into the membership Feb. 6, 1869. Ruth E. was recommended as elder Feb. 5, 1870. Jacob was appointed an elder Oct. 2, 1886. Jacob Frank and John Leander, sons by second wife, Nancy Corenda, were received by request into the Quaker Church in 1897 and Jacob Frank was appointed clerk in 1900. Joseph A. was appointed elder in 1901. This information was taken from "Encyclopedia of American Quaker Genealogy — Vol. I North Carolina" by Dinshaw. Pgs. 1096, 1146, and 1160. The names and birth dates of seven of the children are given on pg. 1146.

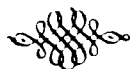

one of the many log houses the Beekers built "here and there over the many acres." This house was on a 128-acre tract on Beaver Creek which John Beeler registered as a North Carolina land grant in April 1780.

In 1821 John Beeler sold 260 acres of the Beaver Creek tract to John Peters. John Peters did not live in this log house, his log dwelling was "back on the hill." In three months, John Peters sold the house and 392 acres of land to Frederick Weaver, a Revolutionary War soldier who migrated to Tennessee from Virginia.

Frederick Weaver, born in 1750, was of German-Dutch descent. His ancestors had the first coat of arms made and given to the Weavers in Germany. The name Weaver was given to them because they were weavers of cloth. The coat of arms bears the crusade cross and crusade for Christ of the Middle Ages.

Frederick Weaver married Catherine Peters and raised a family in this lovely old log home. Frederick deeded three acres of his land for a cemetery, school and church, the latter to be used by "all who worship the Deity in harmony." When Frederick died in 1826, the old homestead was left to his son, Abraham Weaver who lived here with his wife and eight children.

When Abraham died the old family farm was divided between the children. Jacob Emanuel Weaver inherited the log house with a 51-acre tract of land. Five generations of Weavers have lived in the old log home, the last ones being Arlie and Ira Crumley Weaver who married in 1914. (*Legend 196*)

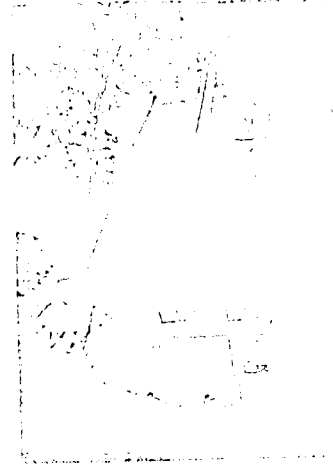

WEAVER HOUSE

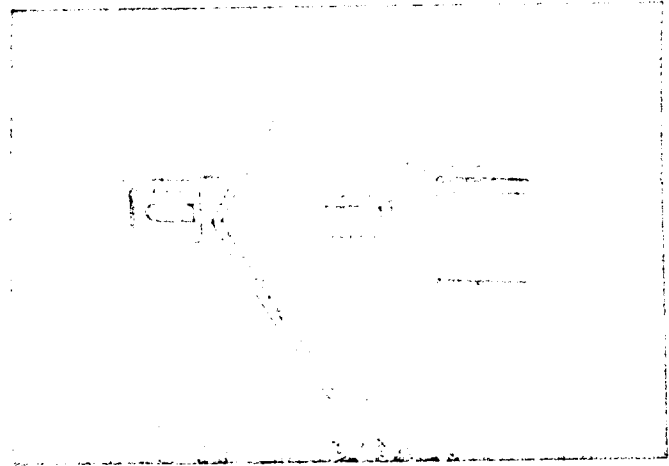
The Weaver house, located on Weaver Pike four miles southwest of Bristol in Weavers Community, is owned and occupied today by Mrs. Ira Crumley Weaver.

This two-story hewn log house with stone foundation and gable stone chimney has been covered with clapboards. The house has a one-story back wing and, according to Mrs. Weaver, is over 200 years old.

The land on which the old log dwelling is located was originally part of thousands of acres which the Beekers purchased from the Cherokee Indians, and the house is believed to

ing is constructed of cream colored brick, topped by a wooden belfry, the bell still tolling worshippers of all denominations on Sunday mornings. Samuel Doak preached to this congregation for two years preceding 1780. Tradition says this church was founded by Joseph Rhea while on one of his trips to Tennessee. Three acres of land were donated by Frederick Abraham Weaver for the original church as a non-denominational institution. The ground around the church has been used as a graveyard. "Many of the first settlers are buried here—among them: a soldier named Bean who was a victim of the accidental discharge of his gun, when returning home with the troops from King's Mountain," states Oliver Taylor. When the modern edifice was built, it replaced a wooden structure facing in the opposite direction.
